The contract between school, parents and students is essential in fostering our core values and developing students that are fully included within the school community and take every opportunity afforded them to achieve 'excellence'.

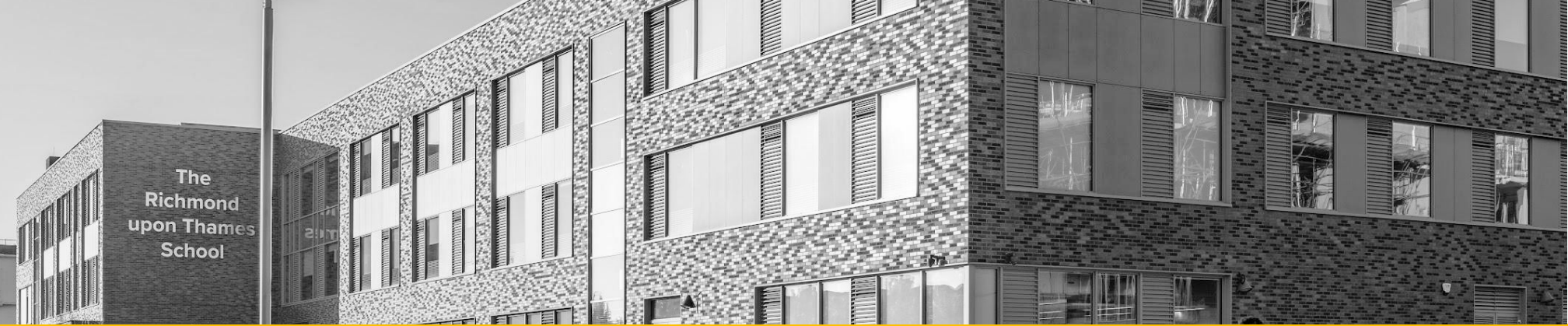
To this end we ask all parents/carers and students to sign this contract to show their commitment to following the content it sets out.
